

Times Microwave T-RAD Success Story: The "Dam" Project

Times Microwave recently provided nearly 20,000 feet of **T-RAD-900-FR cable** for a communications system installed at the Chief Joseph Dam in the state of Washington. This leaky feeder cable system was designed to address safety and communications concerns in the corridors, stairways, equipment control rooms and various levels of this hydro electric dam. The **T-RAD-900-FR cable** was utilized as a backbone feeder system to provide VHF, UHF and 900 Mhz coverage throughout the section of the dam that was covered in phase one of this project. Phase two has also been awarded to Advanced Paging, and we have received another order for **T-RAD-900-FR** leaky feeder cable and LMR-900-FR coaxial interconnect cables. Phase two will start this summer.
